SPECIAL SPOT ROUND ADMISSION PROCESS AND SCHEDULE FOR ADMISSION TO UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS (OTHER THAN B.TECH. PROGRAMS)

(Candidates are advised to read the document carefully before applying for the special spot round)

The special spot round of admissions will be in **OFFLINE MODE** on **28.12.2021**, **Tuesday** (Venue will be announced separately in due course).

Candidates ARE REQUIRED to report physically to the special spot round venue. In the special spot round, seats will be allotted to participating candidates on the basis of combined rank allotted by DSEU against the vacant seats. Candidates have to report to the special spot round venue with a Demand Draft of Rs.10,000 (Ten Thousand Rupee Only) drawn in favour of Delhi Skill and Entrepreneurship University. ONLY THOSE CANDIDATES WILL BE ALLOWED ENTRY TO THE VENUE WHO WILL CARRY A DEMAND DRAFT OF THE AMOUNT MENTIONED ABOVE.

In case the candidate gets the seat, he/she can accept the allotted seat by getting his documents verified and submitting the Demand Draft on the spot round venue. Those who do not accept the offered seat by submitting the Demand Draft, will not be considered for a seat.

1. Special spot round admissions

Vacant seats created after internal upgradation as mentioned at <u>Annexure 1</u> will be made available to the candidates for special spot round of admission

1.1 Participating candidates for spot round

The following candidates are eligible for Special SPOT Round:

Fresh candidates who have not registered yet. Such candidates who want to apply for Undergraduate Degree Program will have to pay a one time non refundable registration fee of Rs 500/- and fill the registration form available on https://dseu.ucanapply.com/.

- a) The registered candidates for Undergraduate Degree Programs who have not been offered any seat till the Spot Round.
- b) The registered candidates for Undergraduate Degree Programs who took admission but withdrew his/her admission later.
- c) Fresh registration of Undergraduate Degree Program candidates who have not

applied for admissions yet by paying a one time non refundable registration fees of Rs. 500/-.

- d) The registered candidates for Undergraduate Degree Programs who were allotted seats in any of the online counselling rounds but did not accept the seat by paying the requisite fee.
- e) The registered candidates for Undergraduate Degree Programs who have not filled any choice during the online registration process.
- f) The registered candidates for Undergraduate Degree Programs who were allotted seats in some round of counselling, paid the seat acceptance fee, but the seat was cancelled due to some deficiency (or any other legitimate reason).

All such candidates who are willing to participate in the special spot round need to submit their willingness on the https://dseu.ucanapply.com/. New candidates who have not registered yet need to first register by paying Rs 500/- and then submit their willingness for participation in the special spot round on the https://dseu.ucanapply.com/.

1.2 Spot round registration and admission process

- A. After the registration candidate needs to report (and mark their attendance) to the spot round venue on 28th December 2021, latest by 10 AM (Venue will be informed separately to the registered students). At the venue, the registered candidates will be called in the order of merit to accept one of the available seats.
- B. Based on the eligibility criteria for the chosen program the documents (as per the list available at <u>Annexure II</u>) will be verified and the fee of **Rs.10,000 (Ten Thousand Rupee Only) will be collected through Demand Draft.** No change in the allotted seat once accepted by the candidate will be allowed, hence candidates should accept the seat carefully.
- C. Candidates may note that once a candidate accepts the seat by paying the seat acceptance fee of **Rs.10,000** (**Ten Thousand Rupee Only**) **through Demand Draft,** he/she will not be eligible for any refund of the amount paid, if he withdraws the seat at a later date
- D. In case, the seat is cancelled by DSEU due to deficiency/deficiencies in documents, the Demand Draft will not be collected.

Documents required for Admission Process - Spot Counselling

Following documents are required on the day of spot reporting on 28th December 2021. Candidates are required to bring the originals and one self attested photocopy.

- Class X marksheet
- Class XII marksheet
- In case of NIOS, the mark sheet must be accompanied with the Centre ID Card.

Note:

Delhi Region Candidates (85% of seats) A candidate passing the qualifying examination from a recognized School / College / Institute located within the National Capital Territory (NCT) of Delhi will be considered for Delhi Region only.

Outside Delhi Region Candidates (15% of seats) A candidate passing the qualifying examination from a recognized School / College / Institute located outside the National Capital Territory of Delhi will be considered for Outside Delhi Region only.

For a candidate, who has passed the qualifying examination through Patrachar Vidyalaya, Delhi / National Institute of Open School, Delhi (NIOS), the criterion for deciding the region shall be the location of his/her centre of examination. In other words, if the centre of examination is located in the NCT of Delhi, the candidate shall be considered under the Delhi Region and if the centre of examination is located outside the NCT of Delhi, he/she shall be considered under the Outside Delhi Region.
