

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

Campus Director participated in "The All India Civil Services Table Tennis Tournament"
















Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangathan Poorvi Delhi organised a sports competition named Khand Stariya Khel Pratiyogita



With that in mind, the writing session aimed to motivate students and cultivate their interest in writing.

The event commenced with an inaugural speech by Respected Bharat sir in the Edusat room at 11:50 A.M. In the beginning, Editor-in-Chief of AGMP, Ms Kiranpreet Kaur introduced the AGMP team to the audience. Then, she listed the objective of the Author's community and encouraged the students to be active members. Then, the discussion delved into the basics of Article Writing. Various kinds of Article Writing were identified by her including- Narrative and Persuasive. The students were provided with the crucial details required for stepping into the thoughtful world of Persuasive writing. They were directed to look for the inspiration from distinct sources and jot down their ideas. Kiran also emphasized the importance of rethinking and revaluating the charted thoughts.

Furthermore, she familiarised the students with the format of an article and importance of having a captivating introduction. Then, the session moved on to the next topic of discussion which was the requirement of a strong vocabulary for a professional-looking article. She identified numerous connecting phrases, emphasising the necessity of their proper placement within sentences. Lastly, the gathering discussed some efficient tools and ways to use them that can aid the writers in enhancing the quality of the articles. The audience was completely engaged and attentive to the speaker's words, eagerly taking in the valuable insights being shared. The lively discussion left the audience thrilled and motivated to apply the newfound knowledge to their own writing projects.

The coordinators of the event, Shivam sir, Bharat sir, Rohit sir, Rajat Halder sir, and Mr. K. Self Defence Training Session for girls students by DLSA



Under the aegis of G20, the Ambedkar DSEU Shakarpur Campus-I collaborated with Deputy Commission of Police (East) to organise a 5 days long, Self Defence Training Programme in association with East District Legal Services for the young girls from 27 February 2023 to 03 March 2023 in the Campus Ground.

ON 27th of February, at 12 noon the event began with the words of encouragement by the event coordinators Mr. K. Dinesh Kumar sir and Mr. Rajat Suvra Halder sir. Then, the organiser of the event, the Head Constable (yoga trainer), Mr. Ashish Kumar addressed the participants. He delineated the objective of awareness for the learning Self Defence Techniques emphasising on the 5-days long government initiative Nari Shakti aimed at raising empowering women. He also elaborated on the importance of yoga in the life of the students. Then the participants were introduced to the basics of self-defense, including body positioning, strikes, and blocks. They also learned about the importance of mental preparedness and situational awareness. The participants were advised to be aware of one's surroundings and take safety precautions to avoid becoming a target.



The second day of the program focused on building on the foundational skills learned on the first day. Participants were taught more advanced techniques such as joint locks and pressure points. They also learned how to use leverage and body mechanics to apply these techniques effectively. Girls were suggested to get loud and push back in case of an attack, which can signal for help and show the attacker that the victim is not an easy target.

The third day of the program further developed participants' mental preparedness and situational awareness skills. They learned how to assess potential threats, identify potential escape routes, and respond appropriately in different scenarios. They were recommended to use everyday objects and leverage one's weight, regardless of size or strength.

On the fourth day, participants were given the opportunity to practice what they had learned in simulated scenarios that included a variety of physical and mental challenges. They also received feedback and coaching from the instructors to help them refine their skills. They were instructed to target the most effective body parts when striking the attacker, such as the eyes, nose, ears, neck, groin, knee, and legs.

The final day of the program further discussed techniques for specific situations, such as how to free oneself from a wrist hold and how to stop an outside strike. At last it brought together all the skills and knowledge learned throughout the week. Participants were given the opportunity to put their skills to the test in realistic scenarios that simulated potential dangerous situations.

The 5-day self-defense program was a success, providing participants with valuable skills and knowledge that will help them stay safe in potentially dangerous situations. The students learnt about the different kinds of violence that may be faced by girls or by women in any place including at home. They received the chance to see the live demo of the self defence techniques as demonstrated by the trainer and the companion cadets. Upon completing the self-defense program, participants expressed feeling more confident and empowered to protect themselves in potentially dangerous situations. They appreciated the program's emphasis on both mental preparedness and physical techniques. The participants found the experience valuable and left with a greater sense of security.







Essay Writing Competition by BIS on "Swachchta Pakhvada"

Under the aegis of G20, an essay writing contest on the theme Swachchta Pakhwada was organised by the Bureau of Indian Standards for the students of Ambedkar DSEU Shakarpur Campus-I on 27 February 2023 in the Edusat room. The event was an hour long from 3:00 PM to 4:00 PM.










GeeksforGeeks organised a seminar on Chat GPT





The speaker of the event Dharamsoth Santosh shared the guidelines provided in the standard pertaining to the safety of participants involved in physical activity and sports, covering areas such as playgrounds, layout, accessibility, maintenance, monitoring, fall surfacing, entrapments, injury prevention, and injury management for educational institutions and community sports academies. These guidelines are intended to be used by primary school teachers, middle and secondary school officials, college and university officials, community sports academies, equipment manufacturers, purchasers and installers, playground designers, architects, engineers, and designers concerned with public playground safety.

The programme was interactive, allowing attendees to exchange ideas and share their experiences related to safety in physical activities and sports. The attendees gaining a deeper understanding of the guidelines provided in the standard. The event was a valuable platform for promoting safety awareness in physical activities and sports in educational institutions and community sports academies. Digital Poster making competition was organized by AGMP Club





The speaker for the event was Ms. Megha Batra, a Legal Service Advocate. The purpose of the program was to raise awareness about the devastating impact of acid attacks and to encourage action to prevent them.

The program was well-attended with a diverse mix of students, faculty, and community members. Ms. Batra began by giving a comprehensive overview of acid attacks, including the causes, effects, and common motivations behind these horrific crimes.

On the premises of Ambedkar DSEU Shakarpur Campus-I, an impactful Nukkad Natak named 'Dastak' was organised on 10 February 2023 by the Delhi State Legal Authority in partnership with the talented actors of Asmita Theatre Group. The natak, directed by the renowned Arvind Gaur, shed light on the issue of violence against women, including acid attacks, and presented a powerful message on the subject.

The Nukkad Natak delineated various forms of violence against women, such as domestic violence, eve teasing, female foeticide, molestation, coercion, mental abuse, denial of space, and freedom of movement. It expressed how women are often held responsible for their own victimization, and how the onus is always on them to be safe, rather than on men to refrain from committing crimes against them.

The performers boldly questioned the societal norms that allow such violence to persist and urged the audience to take the issue seriously and help the victims find justice. The sound effects and synchronisation of dialogues were so impactful that the audience was left reeling, moved to the core by the seamless and immersive experience of the play. A few girls even came forward to share their personal experiences of abuse, which served as a poignant reminder of the severity of the issue.

The credit for organising that impactful Nukkad Natak goes to Mr. Rohit Sharma, the coordinator of the event. The girls were relieved to witness that the faculty understand the challenges they face and hoped to see more such initiatives in the future, to create a safer world.






Volleyball Competition for Diploma Students - Activity Days
