Common Entrance Test (CET) for Diploma courses (full-time)

Minimum Eligibility Criteria

The minimum eligibility criteria for intake of students to all diploma courses are after class X or equivalent with Mathematics as a subject, except for Diploma in Pharmacy.

Exception: To apply for a Diploma in Pharmacy, the candidates must have passed Class XII with Physics, Chemistry and Biology or Mathematics (PCB/ PCM) as subjects.

Admission Process

1. The eligible candidate shall appear for the Common Entrance Test conducted by DSEU. The university will offer admissions through a merit list created on the basis of marks obtained by the candidate in the Common Entrance Test (CET).
2. In addition, the candidate seeking admission to Design-oriented Diploma Courses* (Applied Arts, Interior Design, Fashion Design, Cosmetology & Health and Architecture) must have obtained qualifying marks as specified by the University in Section D of CET.
3. Similarly, the candidate seeking admission to Diploma in Pharmacy course must have obtained qualifying marks as specified by the University in Section E of CET. *The merit list shall include marks obtained by the candidate in Section E, in addition to the marks obtained in Section A, B and C.*

Common Entrance Test (CET)

DSEU will conduct *only* one Common Entrance Test (CET) for all its Diploma courses on the given date. The test is divided into 5 sections, and the structure of the Common Entrance Test is as follows:

Section	Theme	No. of Questions
Section A	Class X Science	25
Section B	Quantitative Aptitude, Logical Reasoning, etc	25
Section C	Communication Skills	25
Section D	Design Aptitude (Applied Arts, Interior Design, Fashion Design, Cosmetology & Health and Architecture)	25
Section E	Class XII Science and Human Body related	10

Please Note -

1. *Section A, B and C are mandatory for all the candidates and the Merit list shall be created on the basis of marks obtained in these sections.*
2. *Section D is mandatory for candidates seeking admission to design-oriented Diploma Courses*

*(Applied Arts, Interior Design, Fashion Design, Cosmetology & Health and Architecture) must have obtained qualifying marks as specified by the University in Section D of CET.**

3. *The candidate seeking admission to Diploma in Pharmacy course must have obtained qualifying marks as specified by the University in Section E of CET. The merit list shall include marks obtained by the candidate in Section E, in addition to the marks obtained in Section A, B and C.*
4. *All questions contain equal marks and there is NO negative marking.*
