- The participants will not be given any TA/DA.
- Participants should make their own arrangements for accommodation, if they require it. The organizers take no responsibility for arranging accommodation.
- Participants' attendance in all training sessions and assessments is compulsory to receive a certificate of completion.
- Participants should carry their laptops for hands-on practice, if required.

### Topic to be covered in FDP

- Facilitation skills including the latest pedagogy and assessment tools
- Design thinking for innovation and problem-solving in and out of the classroom
- Art of data-based storytelling
- Data Visualization using Power BI

1. Understand their role as faculty to educate and equip students with modern-day technology in classroom practices and interactions.
2. Prepare themselves for future classrooms.
3. Achieve efficiency and accuracy in teaching and assessment.

5. Develop strategic thinking and strengthen problem-solving skills to address day-to-day issues in teaching and research.
