ESTABLISHMENT OF INSTITUTIONS INNOVATION COUNCIL

IIC is an Initiative of the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Govt. of India for selected Higher Education Institutes. Ministry of Education (MoE) through MoE's Innovation Cell (MIC) launched the Institution's Innovation Council (IIC) program in collaboration with AICTE for Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) to systematically foster the culture of innovation and start-up ecosystem in education institutions.

It is established to engage a large number of faculty, students, and staff in various innovation and entrepreneurship-related activities such as ideation, problem-solving, proof of concept development, design thinking, IPR, project handling and management at the preincubation/Incubation stage, etc, so that innovation and entrepreneurship ecosystem gets established and stabilized in the institute.



The first meeting of IIC was held on 27th April 2023, to discuss the formulation and function of IIC for the academic year 2022-23 and to assign roles and responsibilities among newly joined council members. The activities for quarter III were also planned and discussed in detail. Dr. Anurag Dixit, president of IIC expressed his gratitude to all the council members for taking up their respective responsibilities and showing their willingness for conducting all the upcoming events of quarter III.

EXTERNAL RELATIONS AND COLLABORATIONS

SHORT TERM COURSE UNDER PMKVY SCHEME

GB Pant DSEU Okhla 1 Campus has launched a Software Developer Associate short term course under the PMKVY scheme starting from 6th April 2023. The course aims to upskill 60 enrolled students with the help of experienced trainers to keep up with emerging trends. The curriculum includes 78 hours of theory and 132 hours of practical training, covering topics like developing software code to specification, understanding Business Requirements Specification (BRS), Software Requirements Specification (SRS), High Level Design (HLD), and Low Level Design (LLD). The course also emphasizes creating appropriate unit test cases (UTCs) and complying with organizational policies, procedures, and guidelines when developing software code to specification. Additionally, the course also focuses on employability skills to make students ready for apprenticeships and jobs.

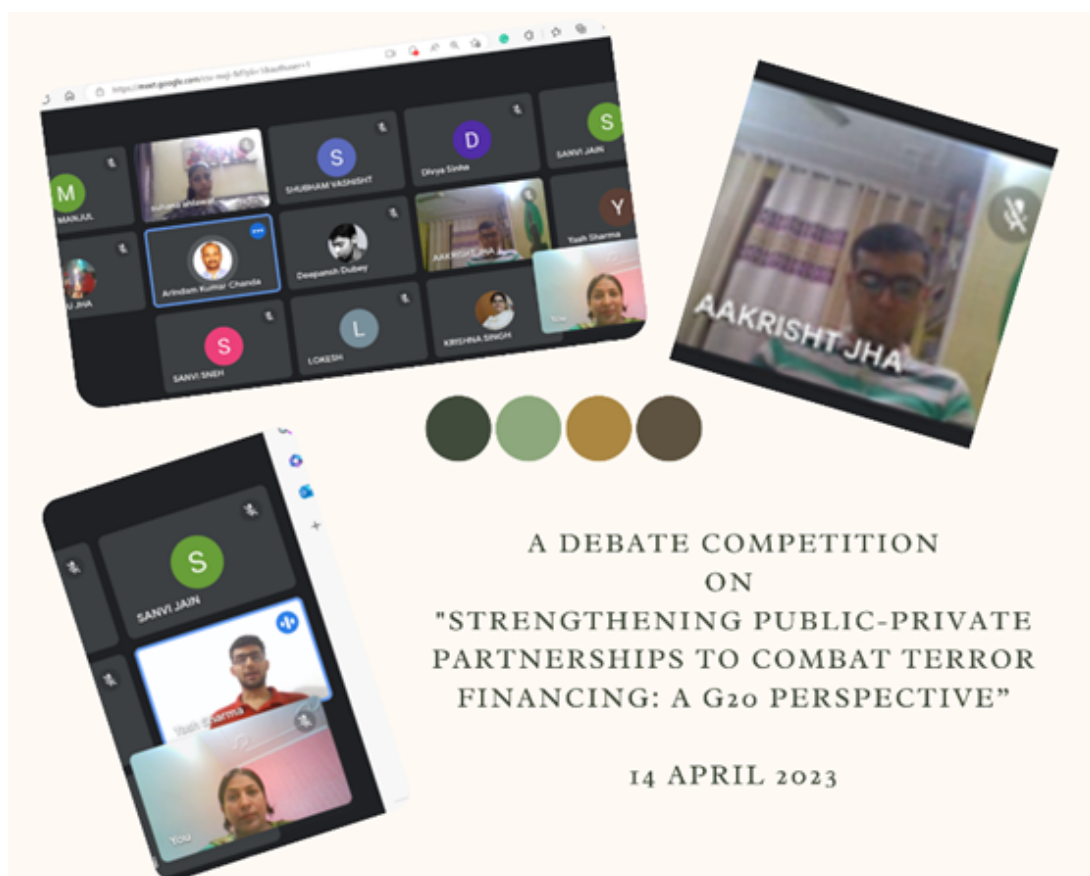


STUDENT ACTIVITIES AND ACHIEVEMENTS

DEBATE COMPETITION
