PLACEMENT HIGHLIGHTS

In the month of March 23, AIRTEL visited campus for placements for the post of Graduate Engineer Trainee. 4 girl students were placed at the package of 5 Lacs per annum. Three students from the 2023 CSE batch have secured positions in BINARY SEMANTICS, with an annual salary package of 5 Lacs. Similarly, three other students from the same batch have been selected by ARI Simulation, with an annual package of 5 Lacs. Furthermore, eleven students from our final year have secured positions at GROWUPP, with a package of 10 Lacs per annum. Similarly, six students from the B.Tech final year have been selected by DAIKIN, with an initial package of 4.5 Lacs per annum, which will be revised to 5.5 Lacs after one year. In addition to these successes, four students from the B.Tech ECE program have secured positions at SATYAM SOFTWARE SOLUTIONS PRIVATE LIMITED, with a package of 4 LPA. Two students from the B.Tech MAE program have also been selected by ERISHA AGRITECH, with a package of 4.5 LPA.

TALK ON WOMEN'S HEALTH AND NUTRITION



The event, which was conducted on the online platform Zoom, had 95 registered participants. The event coordinator, Ms. Aman Saini, welcomed the audience, which included the Campus Director, Prof. (Dr.) Dipali Bansal, faculty members, and students. Ms. Saini introduced DSEU and G B Pant DSEU Okhla-I Campus and briefly discussed the G20 Presidency and International Women's Day. She also explained the theme of International Women's Day 2023 - Embrace Equity - and encouraged everyone to work towards gender equality.





Dr. Mandeep Kaur, a senior clinical fellow in robotic, emergency, and upper GI surgery at University Hospital Sussex, Brighton, U.K, was the speaker for the event. Ms. Saini introduced Dr. Kaur to the participants and highlighted her achievements. Prof. (Dr.) Dipali Bansal welcomed Dr. Kaur and all the participants with the famous quote "Communities & Countries and Ultimately the world is as strong as the health of their women." Prof. Bansal stressed the importance of women's health, both physically and emotionally, and education. She also emphasized that educating a woman means educating a family, society, and nation.

Dr. Mandeep Kaur started the session in an interactive way by asking everyone to calculate their Body Mass Index (BMI). She talked about physical health and nutrition guide, emotional health, mental health, social health, and obesity-related problems. She also emphasized the need to create a gender-neutral environment and provided guidelines for a healthy diet. The audience asked several questions, which were answered satisfactorily by the speaker. Overall, the session was interactive and fruitful.
